To include works by Bach, Vivaldi, Sweelinck, Bull, Hindemith, Parry and Walton, concluding with the famous Toccata from the 5th Symphony by Widor.

The organ at St Augustine's was built by the prestigious firm of Harrison and Harrison of Durham. Though best known for their large organs such as those at the Royal Festival Hall, King's College Cambridge and Westminster Abbey, they have also built a number of smaller organs and that at St Augustine's is widely considered to be one of the finest instruments of its size in the South of England.
